Accredited Media Regulations

Accredited media working in Rimi Riga Marathon areas, including on the course, must follow all rules, instructions, and directions set by the event organizers.

Accredited media must wear the organizer-provided vests and accreditation materials when in restricted areas, such as the finish zone or on the course.

Finish zone and mix zone

- Accredited media can take their positions in the finish zone and mix zone 30 minutes after the start or earlier for the 10km and 6km races.
- Accredited media must give priority to TV crews and photographers by avoiding any interference or obstruction of camera views, especially during the leaders' finish.
- The priority order in the mix zone is as follows: Latvian Television, TV, radio, print press, online press, and others.

Please note that while all race leaders will pass through the mix zone (unless they require medical assistance), they are not obligated to speak to the media if they choose not to.

- Accredited media must follow all instructions and any last-minute changes from the Rimi Riga Marathon finish zone coordinator, technical director, and security.

Courses

- Due to the large number of participants, the number of bicycles will be limited. The organizers will prioritize media based on criteria such as collaboration partners, published coverage, etc.
- Accredited media working on the Rimi Riga Marathon course are strictly prohibited from using any vehicles (motorized or non-motorized) without a transport permit issued by the event organizers.
- Accredited media must strictly prioritize participants' safety by keeping a safe distance from other participants and not disturbing their pace or running direction.

- Accredited media with permission to use vehicles are strictly prohibited from moving between runners, especially in a crowd of runners. Vehicles may only move in the direction of the runners and must stay as close to the outer edge of the track as possible.
- Accredited media vehicles are strictly forbidden from crossing the finish line. All vehicles must exit the course before reaching the fenced finish area, which begins near Vanšu Bridge.

If accredited media do not follow the rules mentioned above, the Rimi Riga Marathon organizers may revoke their accreditation. In case of serious violations, media participation in Rimi Riga Marathon events may be restricted for several years.

By signing, I confirm that I have read and agree to follow all rules and regulations.

If a media representative arrives to collect multiple accreditations for colleagues, the media representative is responsible for ensuring that all recipients have read and understood the rules. In this case, the media representative assumes responsibility on behalf of their colleagues.
